The Lives and Livelihoods Fund (LLF) is a leading international development initiative funded by an unprecedented global coalition including Abu Dhabi Fund for Development (ADFD), Gates Foundation (GF), Islamic Development Bank (IsDB), Islamic Solidarity Fund for Development (ISFD), King Salman Humanitarian Aid and Relief Centre (KSRelief), and Qatar Fund for Development (QFFD).

The LLF leverages collective momentum and concessional financing to provide accessible, sustainable funding to IsDB member countries, ensuring their populations have access to the essential building blocks of prosperity—primary healthcare, productive agriculture, and social infrastructure.

Our work spans the project lifecycle—from pipeline development to technical support—ensuring that every individual has the chance to build a meaningful life and livelihood.

## LLF 1.0: A Proven Model Impact to Date

**Across Islamic Development Bank member countries,  
281 million people are living in extreme poverty.**

LLF 1.0 has made a significant impact by financing 37 projects across 22 IsDB member countries and contributing to the attainment of 9 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). With a portfolio that includes initiatives in primary healthcare, agriculture, and social infrastructure, our investments have improved access to immunizations for 40M+ children, treated millions of health cases, enhanced agricultural productivity, and connected communities to reliable water and sanitation services.



## Global health. Global wealth.



Positive health outcomes are essential to saving lives and transforming livelihoods. Actual and projected results for the Lives and Livelihoods Fund to date demonstrate meaningful progress in primary healthcare:

**400M+** immunizations administered

**38M+** malaria cases treated

**2.4K** health facilities built, upgraded, or equipped

**35K+** health personnel trained

## Seed money



The Lives and Livelihoods Fund has invested in agricultural productivity, a key component of nutrition, food security, and climate adaptation for smallholder farmers. Actual and projected results include:

**65K+** farmers trained and provided with crop varieties resistant to the effects of climate change

**180K** jobs created

**719K** hectares of land improved for increased production and efficiency

## Building the basics



The Lives and Livelihoods Fund is working to deliver access to clean water, sanitation, electricity, and other foundational services. Actual and projected results include:

**7M+** people set to benefit from inclusive, safely managed water and sanitation services

**26** sludge processing plants built

**13K+** households and social facilities connected to electricity





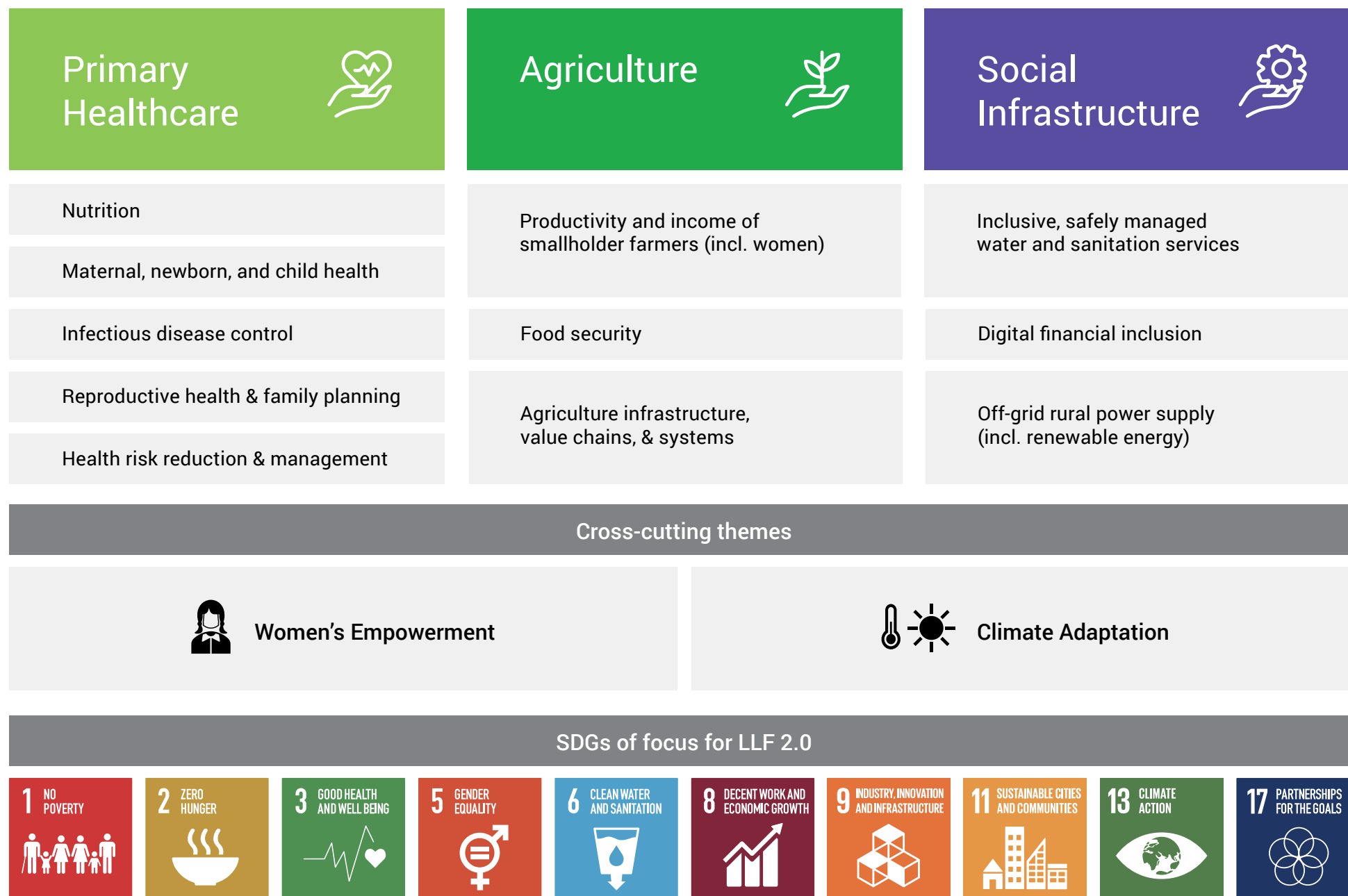
Despite significant impact and relentless effort, the current level of development aid is insufficient to take on entrenched and complex challenges across the three critical sectors, all of which have direct bearing on the lives and livelihoods of millions of people. In addition, challenges persist: the spread of malaria, dengue fever, and water- and foodborne illnesses is on the rise, while food security in Africa and Asia remains precarious amid inflation, extreme weather, and conflict. These pressing issues inspire us to do more.

## LLF 2.0: Building on Impact, Experience and Momentum

To elevate our impact and respond to growing development needs, we are embarking on LLF 2.0—a strategic evolution designed to expand socio-development investments from \$1.4 billion to \$3 billion while reinforcing our commitment to collective action, innovative financial solutions, and comprehensive project support.

The LLF 2.0 will introduce a refreshed, agile approach to funding—combining innovative financing techniques and enhanced technical assistance. Primary healthcare, agriculture, and social infrastructure will be the main focus areas, with a cross-cutting emphasis on women's empowerment and climate adaptation.

LLF 2.0 introduces greater concessionality, fostering economic resilience through financing tailored to the development needs of the nations we serve.
